

Student Scientific Session 2026

On May 15, 2026, the Student Scientific Session took place. For this edition, within the **Design, Engineering, and Restoration of Wooden Products section**, 18 projects were submitted by students from the bachelor's and master's degree programs at the Faculty of Furniture Design and Wood Engineering.

The topics addressed by the students were various, covering diverse subjects such as furniture design, decorative techniques, furniture restoration, wood circularity, and timber construction.
